Class 4- Quality Assurance – Contestants must be able to identify five types of poultry diseases. Level III and IV contestants should also know how the disease is transmitted and treated.

Level I and II should identify five diseases and match name only.

Points: 5 points per disease – 25 total points

Levels III and IV should identify five diseases and match transmission and treatment of each identified disease.

Points: 5 points per correct answer-25 total points

If level III or IV contestant misses the disease or transmission/treatment of the disease, they will receive half credit. (2.5 points)
