At participating **GROCERY STORES**

- **BUY** fresh vegetables and fruit with your SNAP EBT card.
- **EARN** \$1 FREE Double Up Food Bucks for every \$1 you spend on fresh produce.

 Get your earned Food Bucks on your loyalty card, store account or coupon.
- **SPEND** your Double Up Food Bucks on more fresh vegetables and fruit.

At participating FARMERS MARKETS

- BUY SNAP tokens with your SNAP EBT card at the farmers market info booth.

 These tokens can be used to buy any SNAPeligible item.
- **GET** a matching amount of Double Up Food Bucks tokens. These tokens can be used to purchase vegetables and fruit.
- SHOP! Look for vendors who accept the SNAP and DUFB tokens.

SNAP, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, is the federal nutrition program formerly known as food stamps. Participants use electronic benefits transfer (EBT) cards to buy program-eligible foods.


