Consider the individual's credentials. Does the author have the experience or education to be an expert on this topic?



#### What's the website's goal?




A for-profit website might be more likely to share biased information. Consider why a website might want to share certain information with their audience.

## What's their source?

Beware of internet posts that don't cite their source!

Reliable internet sources will ALWAYS share where they got their information.





## What's the web address?

Look for websites that end in .GOV & .EDU

Avoid sites ending in .COM .NET or .ORG
