### Who Wrote it?

Consider the individual's credentials. Does the author have the experience or education to be an expert on this topic?



### What's the website's goal?

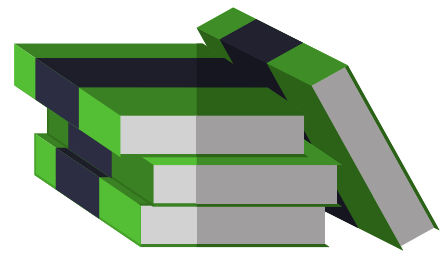
A for-profit website might be more likely to share biased information. Consider why a website might want to share certain information with their audience.



### What's their source?

Beware of internet posts that don't cite their source!

Reliable internet sources will ALWAYS share where they got their information.



### What's the web address?

Look for websites that end in **.GOV** & **.EDU**

Avoid sites ending in **.COM** **.NET** or **.ORG**
