#### **Pick-up or Delivery**

- Minimize your risk by opting for pick-up or delivery when possible
- If you need to go inside the store, practice social distancing, and try going during less busy hours to avoid crowds



#### **Have a Plan**



- If possible designate one person from your household to go to the store
- Have a list of the items
- Check store hours and policies before you arrive
- Have your method of payment handy to check out quickly

## **Wear a Mask or Face Covering**


## While Shopping

- Respect one direction arrows in aisles
- Stay 6 feet away from others
- Shop with your eyes, not your hands
- Avoid high touch surfaces
- Check for wipes at the entrance and sanitize your cart or basket



#### **Leaving the Store**

- When you leave the store, use hand sanitizer and immediately wash your hands when you get home.
- Remember to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water.
