Clothing Judging Schedule

Date: Tuesday, July 21

Location: Dreher Family 4-H Building and Building 21 located on the Douglas County Fairgrounds

Arrival Time: All 4-H'ers should arrive and check in no later than 8:30 a.m.

Shopping in Style

- Check-in will take place in Building 21 between 8:00–8:30 a.m.
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Sewing & Textiles

If your 4-H'er is exhibiting a constructed (sewn) garment or textile item:

- Please arrive to the Dreher Family 4-H Building by 8:30 a.m. to sign up for a consultation judging time.
 - In the afternoon, members modeling their constructed garments will model in Building 21.
 - Our goal is to begin the construction modeling portion at 12:30 p.m.
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Public Fashion Revue

All members participating in Shopping in Style or Sewing & Textiles are required to participate in the Public Fashion Revue. This year's theme is "Together We Shine."

Date: Wednesday, July 22

Time: 7:00 p.m.

Location: Building 21

Please remember:

- Arrive by 6:45 p.m.
 - Each 4-H'er will model one outfit.
 - A narrator will read a script describing each outfit.
 - Fashion Revue scripts are due Thursday, July 16.

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What to Bring on Judging Day

Please bring:

- Clothing, shoes, and accessories for each outfit.
- Required paperwork placed in a plastic sleeve (plastic sleeves will also be available onsite).
- One printed photo of the front and one printed photo of the back of each completed outfit, including all accessories that will be modeled.

Having your paperwork completed before judging day will help make check-in smoother and reduce stress. All required forms can be found [HERE](#). Please note: The Cost Per Wear form is required only for Level 4 exhibitors. Judges do not consider this form for Levels 1, 2, or 3.

Leaving Clothing Exhibits

Members are welcome to leave their clothing exhibits:

- Following Clothing Judging on Tuesday, July 21, or
- After the Public Fashion Revue on Wednesday evening.

Clothing racks and hanger labels will be available at the south end of Building 21.

If you choose not to leave your exhibit during judging week, the final opportunity to check in clothing exhibits will be: Monday, July 27 from 1:00–5:00 p.m. in Building 21.

Please remember:

- All clothing exhibits must be displayed on a swivel hanger.
- Each exhibit must include its scorecard and ribbon attached to the hanger.
- Swivel hangers will be available for pickup during Clothing Judging on July 21.
