Senior Meals

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

Description: CSFP serves a monthly food package to people 60 years of age or older with income less than 130% of the Federal Poverty Level (https://tinyurl.com/yyctyjkm). A monthly food package contains 10 food groups including: cheese, shelf stable milk, nonfat dry milk (every other month), peanut butter or dry beans,

cereal, meat, vegetables, fruits, juice, and instant potatoes, rice or pasta.
